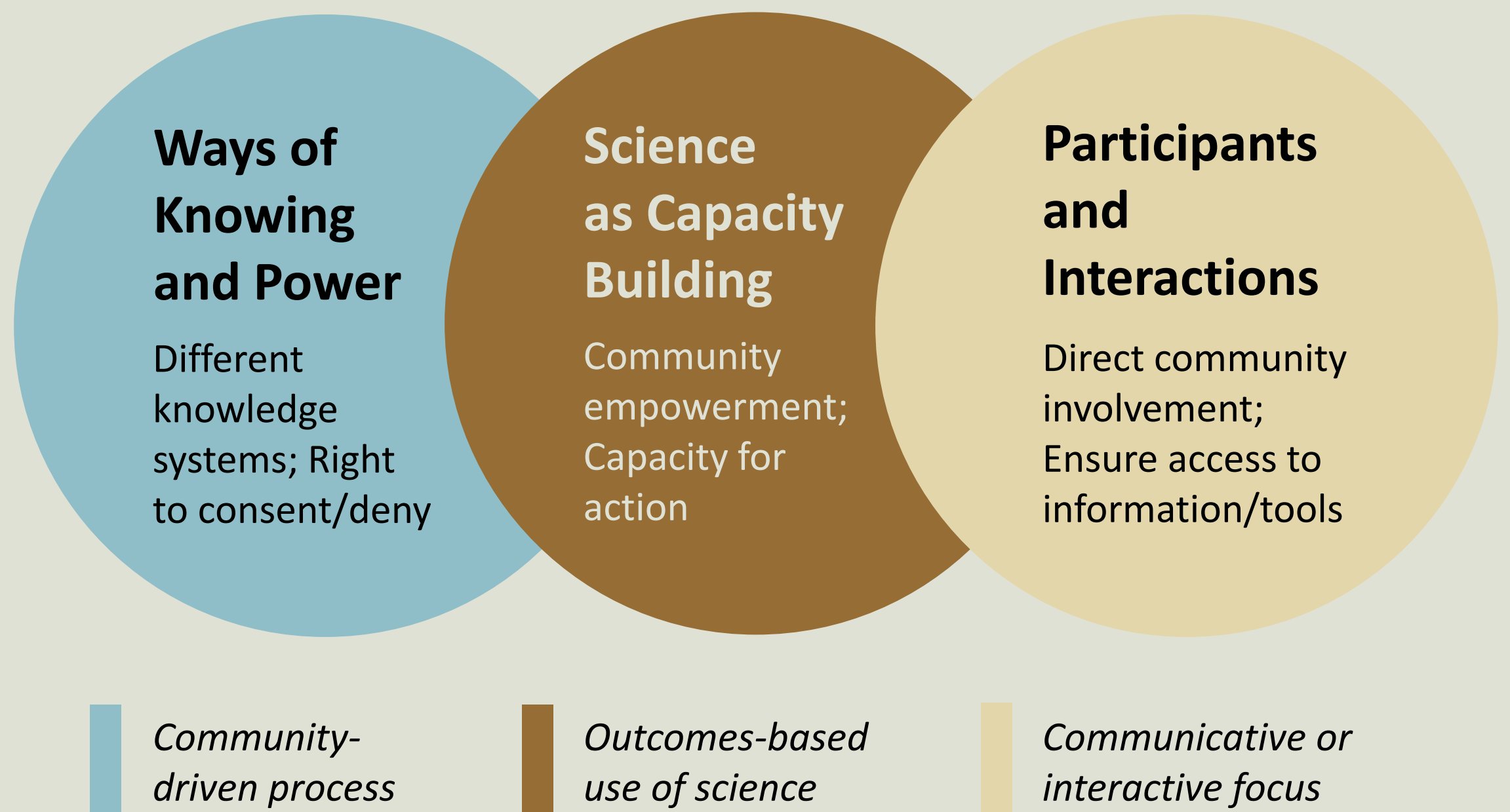


WHAT CONSTITUTES EQUITABLE CO-PRODUCTION?
